Booking Info

I notice some "tell me your real name" requests from a few leaders in private and Message Board Notes. The participant's Full Name is available in the Booking Info tab.

It is true that not all full names are displayed in an activity's Participants list view. This is determined by the participant's Privacy settings. However, having the Full Name available to the leader in the Booking Info tab balances the individual's need for privacy and security with the leader's need for information concerning the activity's participants.
