
Have I Walked with You?

A recent update to Bilby includes a handy new feature which lists shared activities in common.

1. Go to the Members list



2. Use the Quick members search to search for a member of interest



3. Use View to bring up the member's details



4. Scroll down to see the activities you have shared. Bingo!

Bilby Tagging and Email Alerts

1. When communicating with a single participant via a Note, tagging is not necessary. Only you as the activity leader and the participant can see the note
2. When communicating with all/multiple participants via the Message Board, tags ARE necessary (without @tags, no Bilby email alert is generated, and no one is aware of the note). Separate @tags by at least 1 space or, better still, place each @tag on a new line. This ensures that all Bilby email alerts are correctly generated
3. That said, Bilby email alerts of Message Board entries can be delayed. These email delays are beyond the control of Bilby. If an activity of yours is imminent and you are expecting Message Board responses from participants, it is good practice to check the Message Board directly.
