Weather

Snow will stop and it will get warm. For Summer months, go early (if it's an A-shaped walk get the climb over before the day heats up), go wet (cool off in a creek or river when needed) or go high (around 2/3 of a degree C is lost for every 100m up). Check that participants have plenty of water and a pressure immobilisation (snake) bandage in their personal first aid kit, as well as sun protection.

Social Media Influence on Hiking

News reports are saying that influencers and other posters of photos are glamourising hiking destinations, minimising the risks of reaching such locations and reducing the preparedness of walkers. Difficulties are rarely mentioned. (This is definitely not the case with CBC social media posts.)

Of the many ways mentioned to prevent disappointments and potential rescues, joining a bushwalking club was prominent.
