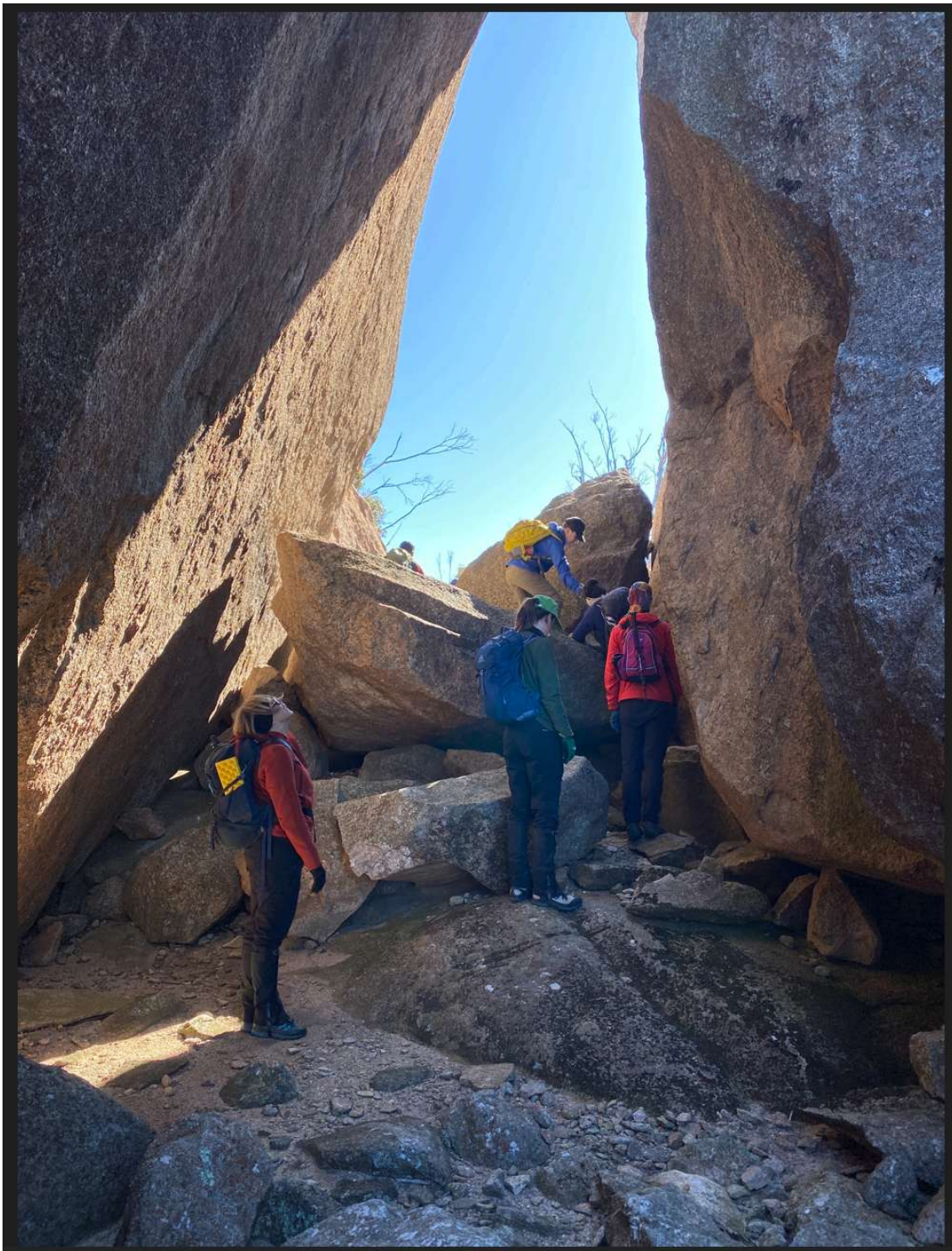

Use Message Board for Final Arrangements

Imagine this scenario – the Check-in Officer receives a frantic call from the emergency contact of a participant on a multi-day, remote area pack walk. “They’re not home and it’s 9pm.”

If the leader had used the activity’s Message Board to promulgate final details for the trip, the Check-in Officer and other committee members might have seen “... last minute

change, the river is up and we will have to exit via a different route. Estimate return to Canberra now midnight.”

If final details had been sent to participants via email, this valuable information would not be available to club safety officers.

(“Not enough room for complex details on the Message Board,” you say? Use multiple entries and just tag the latest one.)
